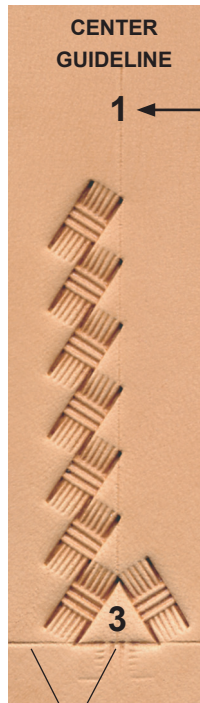




From Tony Laier's Bench:

ARROW Basketweave DESIGN (X511 & F910)

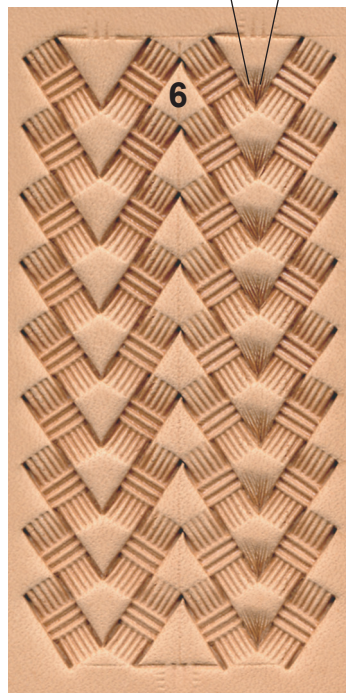


- 1) Scribe a very light guideline.
- 2) Center stamp on guideline and mark ends.
- 3) Begin stamping by forming a triangle using marks. Stamp up one side as shown.



- 4) Stamp up other side of guideline to complete a row.
- 5) To do another row, form another triangle as shown.

- 6) Continue stamping until space is filled.

TIP: When nearing an edge (border), tilt tool creating a partial impression to avoid damaging border.

- 7) **OPTIONAL:** Stamp a F910 where basket stamp impressions form a point. You will need to stamp the F910 twice in each point, moving the tool slightly between each hit.
