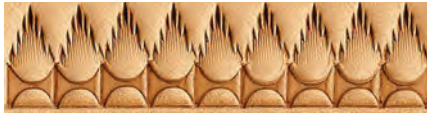




From Tony Laier's Bench:

BORDER DESIGNS USING
D444, F926 & S724

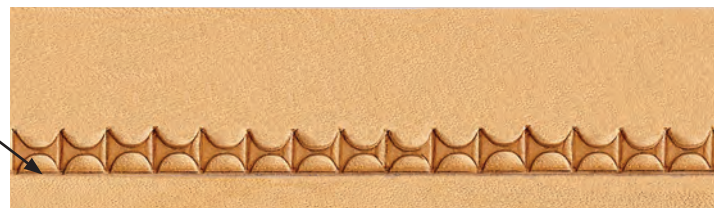


You will need D444, F926 & S724 stamps, straight edge or ruler, stylus, beveler of your choice and swivel knife.

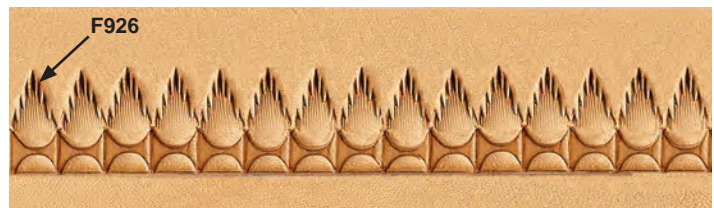
- A) First scribe a light guideline at desired distance from the edge of your cased project leather. Cut the line with a swivel knife run along a straight edge. Bevel inside the line with a smooth or checkered beveler of your choice.



- B) Begin stamping the D444 along cut & beveled guideline touching impressions as shown.



- C) Add F926. Line up 2 ends of F926 with tips of D444, as shown.



- D) Add S724 if desired.
