


"Meander" With Double Line (Bead) Border Using D444 & B893



You will need stamps D444 & B893, straight edge, stylus, beveler of your choice, modeling tool and swivel knife. (Use D443 or D445 for different sizes.)

- A) First make a light #1 guideline on your cased leather at desired distance from edge of your project. Use a straight edge and stylus.
- B) Scribe #2 guideline 1/8" from #1.
- C) Measure face of tool and add 1/2 that measurement.



- D) Using measurement above (1-1/2 x face of tool), scribe #3 guideline.
- E) Scribe #4 guideline 1/8" from #3.
- F) Cut guidelines with a swivel knife run along a straight edge. Round off double line (bead) borders with spoon end of a modeling tool. Drag tip of B893 along rounded beads to create a texture. If desired, bevel inside double line beads with your choice of a beveler or use the spoon end of a modeling tool.
- G) Begin stamping aligning stamp on #2 guideline. Make next impression off of #3 guideline as shown. Continue.
