



# **Digital Downloads**

This PDF package has been put together to give you options when it comes to printing. Some PDF file downloads may contain some documents larger than an 8-1/2" x 11" image. Pages and patterns that are larger than 8%x11 have been provided in two formats:



**Full Size:** If you would like to have a full size print out, take the full size pages to your local print shop and they can print it for you.

**Tiled:** The tiled pages give you the option of printing the larger patterns at home. You print the tiled pages and then assemble them to make the larger patterns.



<u>Pattern PDF files</u> are typically laid out as follows: Cover (if applicable), instructions sheets (if applicable), pattern 1 – full sized, pattern 2 – full sized, pattern 2 – tiled, pattern 3 – full sized, pattern 3 – tiled. ...Etc.


<u>Doodle Page PDF files</u> are typically laid out as follows: Front – full sized, front – tiled, back – full sized, back – tiled (Some Doodle Pages do not have backs).

<u>eBook PDF files</u> contain 1 (one) full eBook. All pages in the PDF are full sized. This means that you may have to take the PDF to a print shop for certain oversized books if your home printer cannot print the larger pages.

<u>Craftaid PDF files</u> contain 1 (one) full Craftaid pattern or Craftaid pattern pack that has been converted into a tracing pattern. All pages in the PDF are full sized. This means that you may have to take the PDF to a print shop for certain oversized Craftaid patterns if your home printer cannot print the larger pages. *NOTE: These digitized patterns do not include any of the physical plastic templates (Craftaids) that may be mentioned, nor does the purchase of this PDF file imply a promise to receive any physical plastic templates (Craftaids).* 

NOTE: Digital kit patterns do not include any kit parts that they may reference.

Please note: When printing on a home printer, use the settings seen on the image to the right in the Page Handling area of the Adobe Reader print dialogue box. If your printer is cutting edges off, set "Page Scaling" to "Shrink to Printable Area". This will, however, decrease the size of the pattern a very small amount.



NOTE: Some patterns may reference tools, and other items no longer available.

NOTE: You may take this PDF file to your local print shop to have the full-size pages printed for your own personal use.

## **Angel Barrette**

#### You will need:

2 to 5 oz. Tooling Leather


Leather Weld #2015 White & Medium Flesh Cova Colors #2041 Silver Starlight Acrylic Paint #2039 Gold Starlight Acrylic Paint #2038 21/4" Barrette Clip #1137 Craft Knife #1583 Super Glue Gel #2030

Step 1: Cut angel body and wings out of tooling leather with a craft knife.

Step 2: Dampen wings with water. Shape as shown, then let

Step 3: Paint body and wings with Cova Color and Starlight Acrylic Paint.

Step 4: Adhere body to wings with Leather Weld, then adhere barrette clip to completed angel with glue. Note: 1" Pinback #1143 may be used in place of barrette clip.



## Christmas Tree Pin

#### You will need:

2 to 5 oz. Tooling Leather 1" Pinback #1143 Red Seed Beads #1440 Beading Thread #1220 Needle Green Cova Color® #2041 Silver Starlight Acrylic Paint Leather Weld #2015

Super Glue Gel #2030

Step 1: Cut 3 tree parts out of 2 to 5 oz. leather.

Step 2: Dampen each part with water and mold as shown. Let dry completely.

Step 3: Paint each tree part green. After Cova Color has dried, glue tree parts together with Leather Weld. Dab dots of silver Starlight Acrylic Paint on the front side of the tree to represent lights or ornaments.

Step 4: String 3 strands of red Seed Beads on Beading Thread, one for each part of tree. Each strand should be a little longer than widest portion of each tree

Step 5: Attach 3 strands of beads to assembled tree by using Super Glue Gel to glue strand ends on back of tree (see ill.).

# **Holly Earrings**

#### You will need:

2 to 5 oz. Tooling Leather 2 Fishhook Earwires #1140 2 Red 4mm Glass Beads #1450 1/2" Round Drive Punch #2436 Kelly Green Cova Color® #2041 Size 0 Mini Punch (%4") #1766 Needle Nose Pliers

Step 1: Cut 2 holly leaves out of leather using ½" Round Drive Punch. Punch small hole in top of each leaf with Size 0 Mini

Step 2: Dampen leaves with water, then carve veins with a swivel knife or press in with the pointed end of modeling tool. Twist each leaf and let dry. After leaves have dried, paint with kelly green Cova Color.

Step 3: Bend bottom loop of one earwire open with pliers. Slide off metal bead and replace with one red glass bead. Slide on holly leaf, then bend loop closed. Repeat with other earwire.
