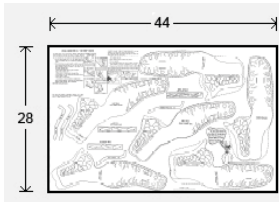




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# From Tony Laier's Bench: Christmas Doorbell Hanger

## Arrowhead Doorbell Hanger

### You will need:

8 Medium Arrowhead Shapes  
7 Bells 1 1/2"  
32 Ft. Red Suede Lace  
1/8" Hole Punch  
Red and Green  
Cova Color

**Step 1:** Color 4 Arrowhead Shapes red and 4 green with Cova Color. Apply finish, if necessary.

**Step 2:** Punch 3 holes in all but one arrowhead as shown in Illus. A. Punch only top hole in remaining arrowhead. This will be the last arrowhead used.

**Step 3:** Cut lace into eight 4 foot long pieces.

**Step 4:** Tie a knot in one end of one 4 foot piece of lace. Thread other end through top hole of one arrowhead from back. Thread lace end back through same hole forming a 2 inch loop (Illus. B).

**Step 5:** Make seven 4 1/2 inch wide bows out of remaining pieces of lace. Tie each bow in center with a piece of waxed thread or string to hold bow together until used (Illus. C).

**Step 6:** Thread end of lace from Step 4 through middle hole in first arrowhead from back. String one bell onto lace. Thread lace end through top hole in second arrowhead then through bottom hole in first arrowhead, from front. Position one bow in loop formed above (Illus. C).

**Step 7:** Pull lace tight securing bell and bow in place (Illus. D). Repeat Steps 6 and 7 with arrowheads, bells and bows. Save the arrowhead that has one hole for last.

**Step 8:** Thread lace end through single hole in top of last arrowhead from front. Pull tight to secure last bell and bow, then tie lace in a knot on back and trim off excess (Illus. E).
