



## Digital Downloads

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**Full Size:** If you would like to have a full size print out, take the full size pages to your local print shop and they can print it for you.

**Tiled:** The tiled pages give you the option of printing the larger patterns at home. You print the tiled pages and then assemble them to make the larger patterns.



**Pattern PDF files** are typically laid out as follows: Cover (if applicable), instructions sheets (if applicable), pattern 1 – full sized, pattern 1 – tiled, pattern 2 – full sized, pattern 2 – tiled, pattern 3 – full sized, pattern 3 – tiled. ...Etc.

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**NOTE: Digital kit patterns do not include any kit parts that they may reference.**

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**NOTE: Some patterns may reference tools, and other items no longer available.**

**NOTE: You may take this PDF file to your local print shop to have the full-size pages printed for your own personal use.**

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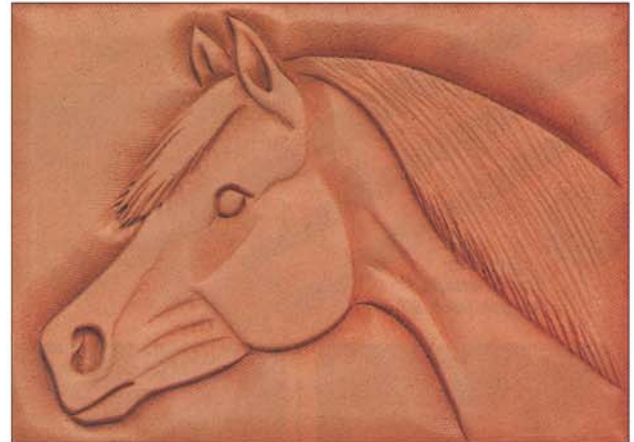
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## 4 Easy Steps to Tooling a Horse Head

You can master these tooling techniques with a little help and practice.



**Step 1.** Use tracing film to transfer design on leather. Use a swivel knife to cut figure into damp leather. Mark, but do not cut dashed muscle tone lines on face and neck area



**Step 2.** Bevel around figure with etched bevelers. Bevel in muscle tone with smooth figure carving bevelers as shown.



**Step 3.** Smooth out beveled muscle tones and round off beveled edges with the spoon end of a modeling tool. Form eye with the pointed spoon end of figure carving modeling tool #8039-03.



**Step 4.** Mat background area with etched matting tools. Lightly cut in hair lines on mane and interior of ear with a swivel knife.



As shown here, this figure carved horse head can be used on any of Tandy Leather's billfold kits. A border design has been added using Craftool stamp D435.
