



ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS



Carve design attach snap parts.





Lace with Whip or single Loop stitch apply leather finish



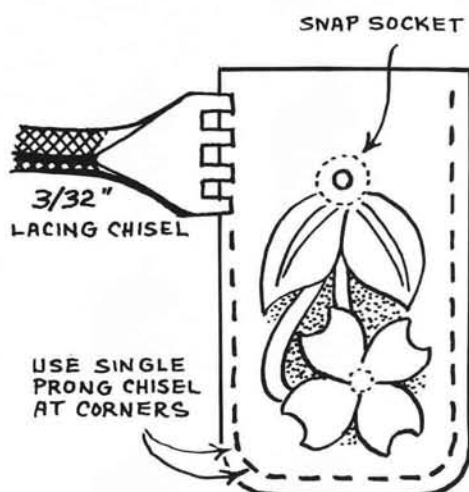
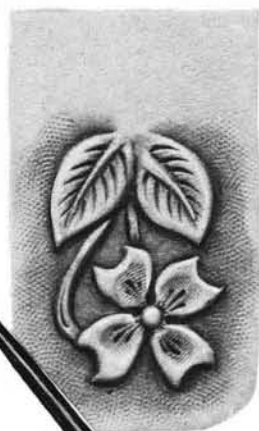
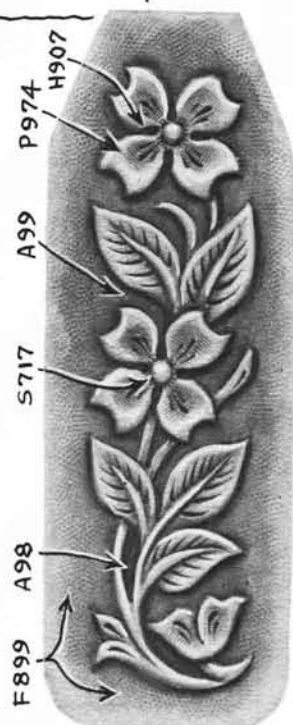
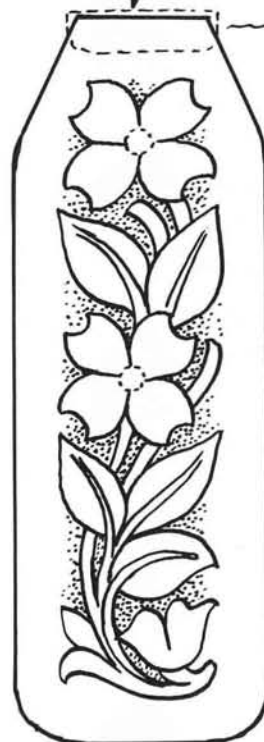

Cement edges of pockets together on flesh sides. Punch lacing holes.

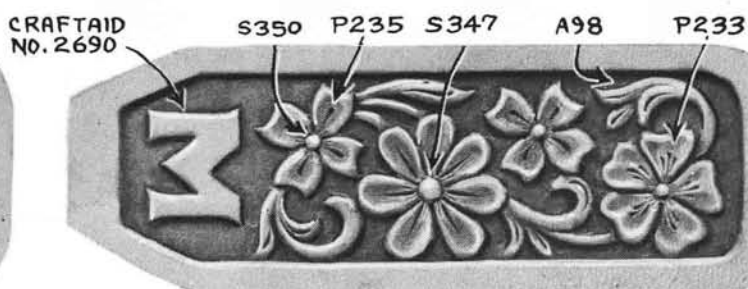
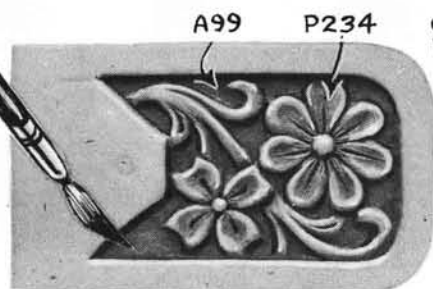


NOTE: Case can be punched with round lacing holes, or sewn by hand, if desired. Unlaced edges should be burnished. Special Note: If you have a kit that is pre-sewed, and you desire to carve the front and back sides... it is advisable to cut the stitching and take the parts loose to carve them. The case can then be re-sewn through the holes, or laced as described.

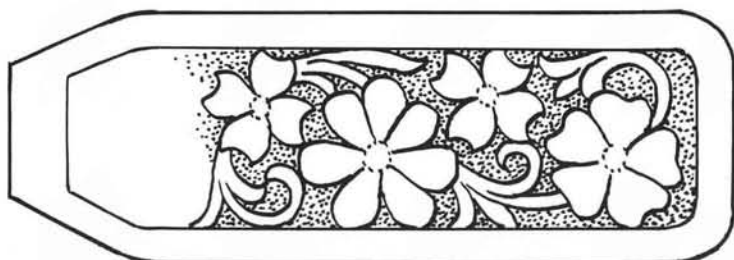
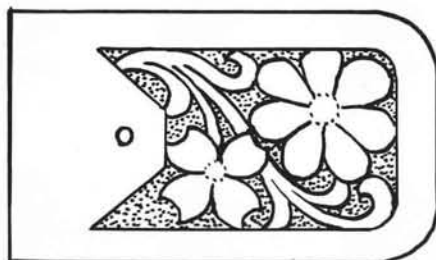

Add colour to your nail cases. Dye background; dye flowers with bright Coxa colours for sparkling effects.



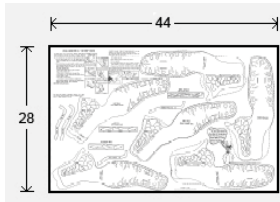

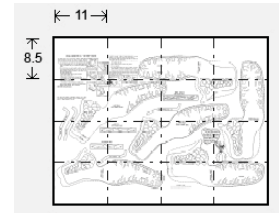
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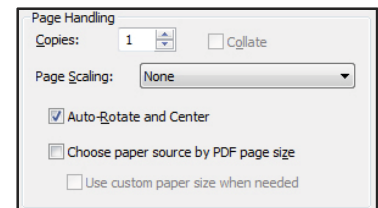
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
