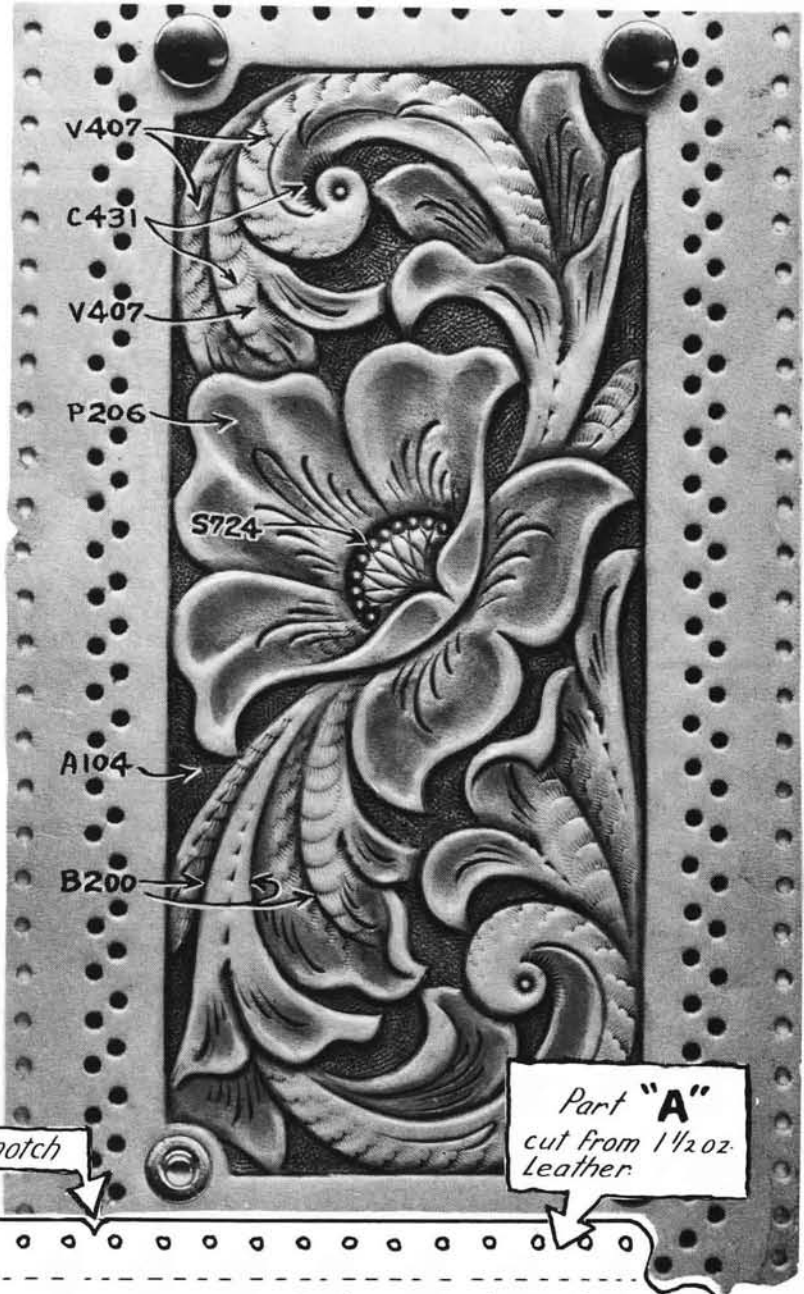
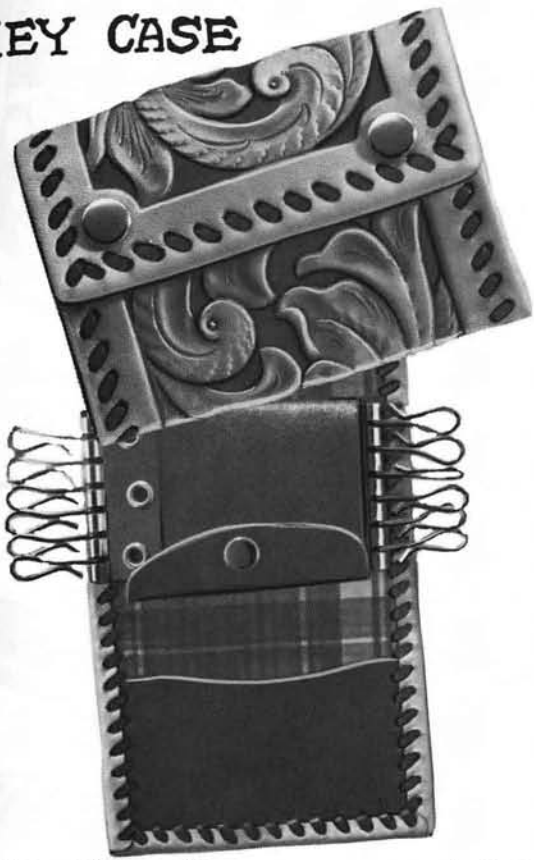
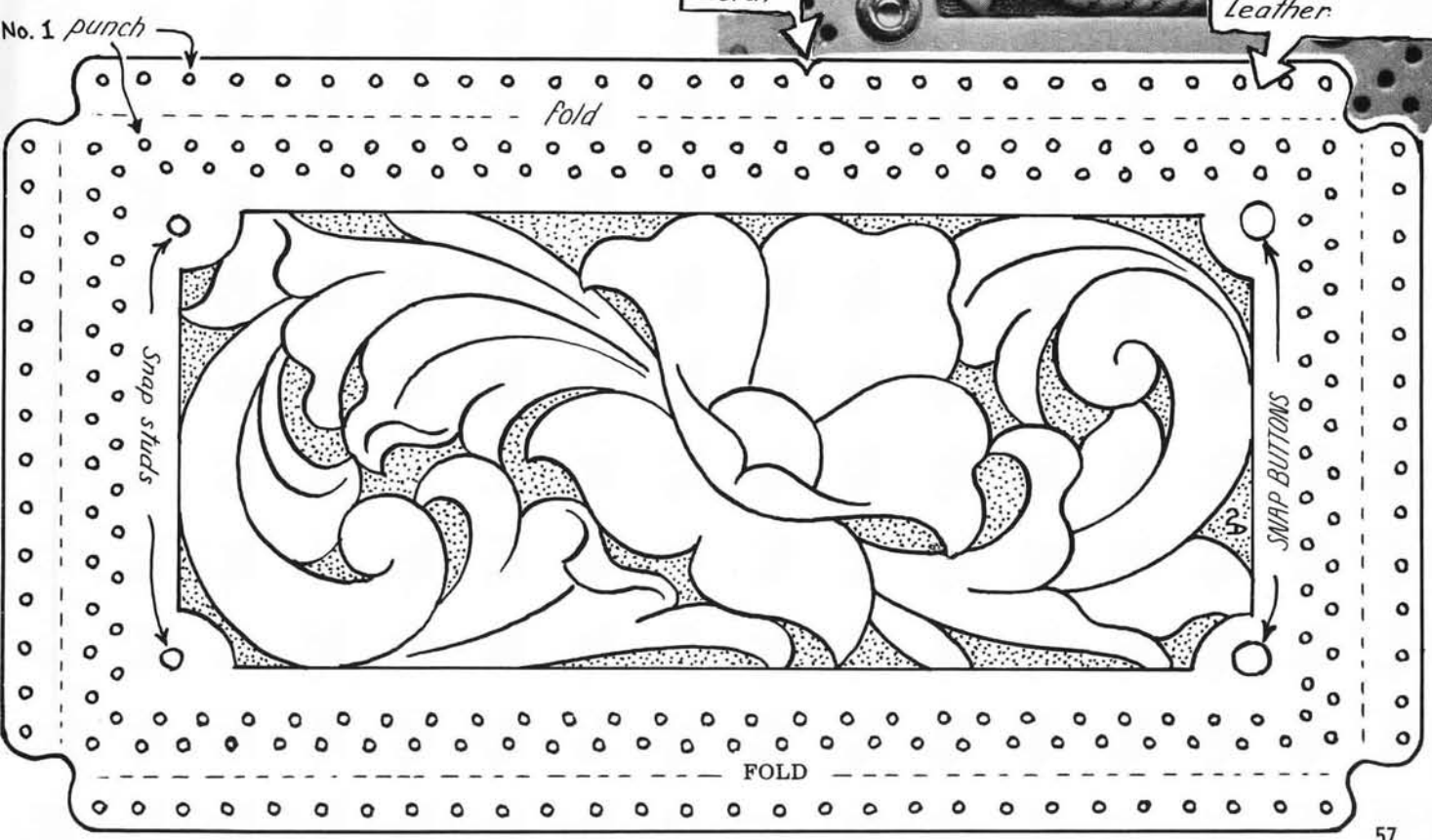


# Spiral Line KEY CASE

*NOTE* when cutting your own project, it is important to be exacting when punching lacing holes in all parts. Be sure to cut "notch" as indicated on patterns.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Flesh side up

Lining

1

Cement lining to flesh side of part A. Lining should cover only inside row of holes as shown above. Re-punch to have holes in lining.

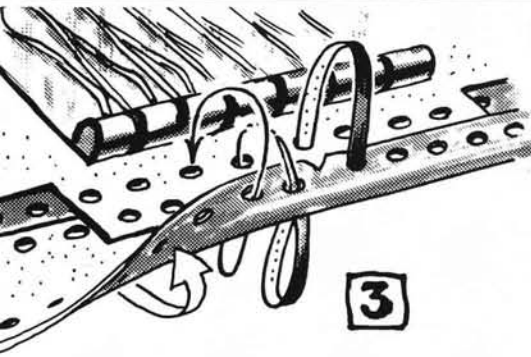
Grain side up

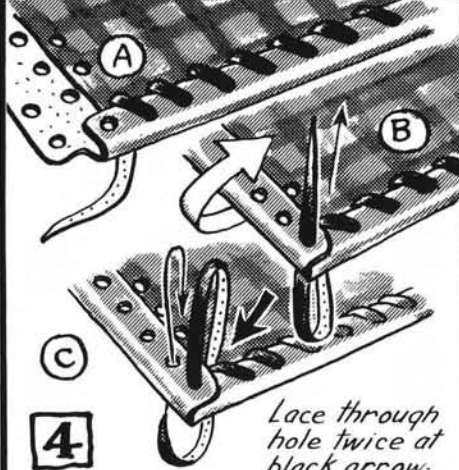
Align holes carefully, cement edges of part C in place. Align notches of parts A and B and begin lacing by bringing lace up through hole next to notch, in part B, as shown. Leave 1/2" of end of lace between parts A and B.

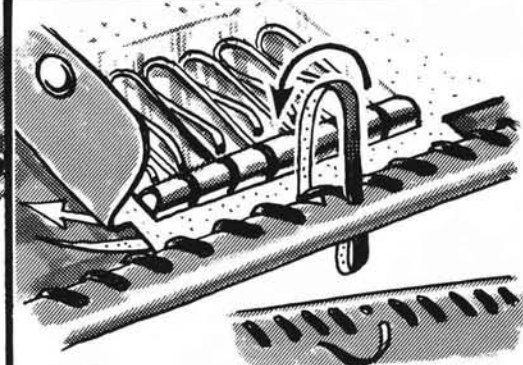
Fold edge of part A over part B. Lace through corresponding hole, next to notch. Run lace down through next hole in the inside row of holes. Continue lacing through holes as shown by small arrow above.

Lace through hole twice at black arrow.

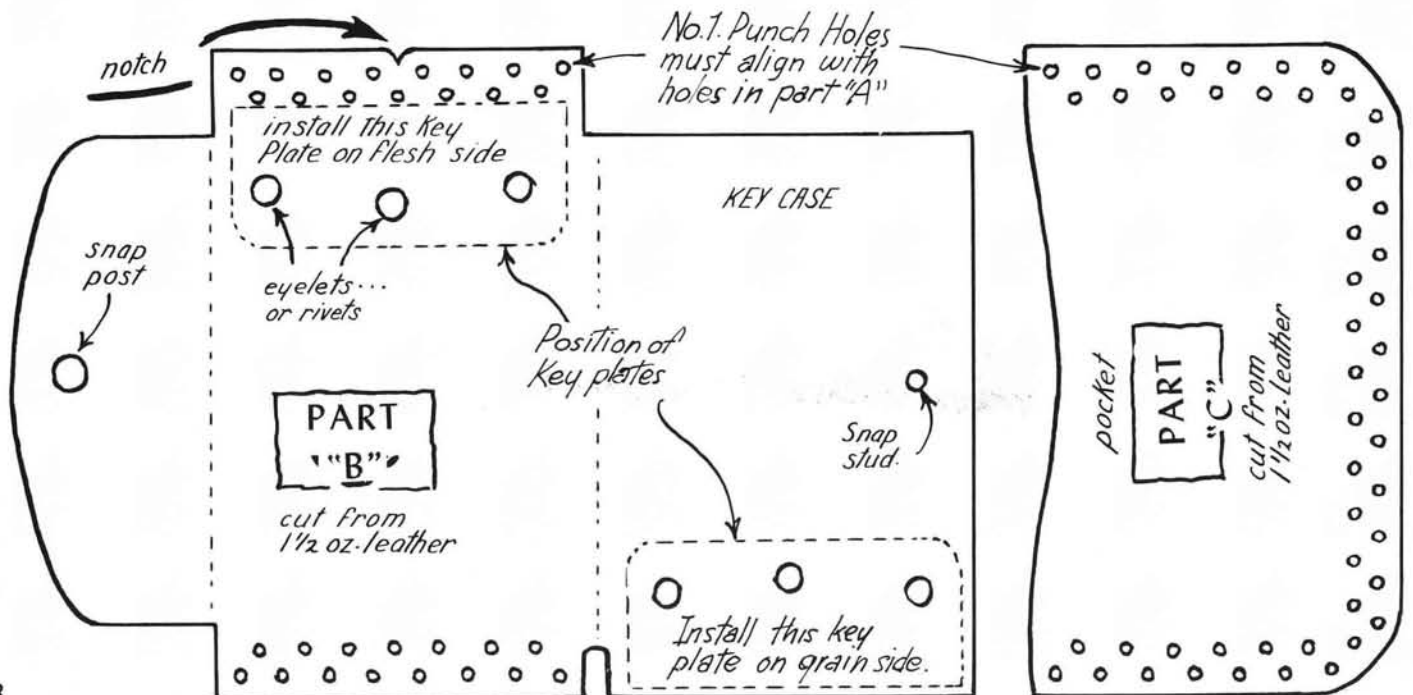
Fold steps A-B-C (above) to complete lacing around the corner.

outside view

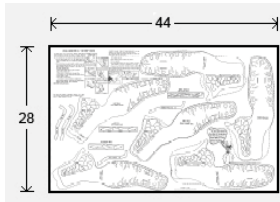
Continue lacing to beginning. Push lacing through last hole and down between parts A and B. Cut off excess lace.





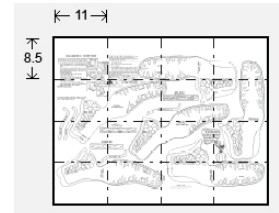
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**Tiled:** The tiled pages give you the option of printing the larger patterns at home. You print the tiled pages and then assemble them to make the larger patterns.



**Pattern PDF files** are typically laid out as follows: Cover (if applicable), instructions sheets (if applicable), pattern 1 – full sized, pattern 1 – tiled, pattern 2 – full sized, pattern 2 – tiled, pattern 3 – full sized, pattern 3 – tiled. ...Etc.

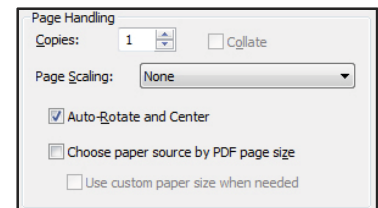
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
