


Tool and Decorate First, See reverse side for carving instructions.



Make Swivel Knife cuts first. Then use tools in the following order.







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
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HOW TO CARVE

All carving and decorating must be done first.

Put tooling leather in clean water and take out immediately. Shake off excess water and wrap in paper or clean cloth. Leather should be right for tooling in 1 hour. Should you want to case leather over night, soak about 2 minutes, then wrap.

- Attach photo carve pattern to leather with paper clips and trace outline of tooling cuts on leather with modeling tool. Make your border around design while leather is damp.
- Don't wait. Cut borders with Swivel Knife. Then cut flower lines into leather, then stems and leaves.

Now your leather is dry enough to stick a piece of heavy paper on back, using rubber cement. The paper will keep tooling leather from stretching so holes will match lining for assembly.

- 3. Do all your background work.
- Take beveler and bevel all your cut lines. Then shade design. BE CAREFUL not to knock your edges down with this tool.
- Decorative tools are next. Then use your Swivel Knife again and put decorative cuts in your shaded spots on petals and leaves.

Remove paper when leather is completely dry.



HOW TO ASSEMBLE

- 1. Tool design first.
- Cement foam rubber to center of tooled leather back. Cement back of tooled leather and back of lining. Allow 5 minutes to dry, then press together. Be sure holes match!
- Start lacing at top right of kit. Lace completely around then whip lace across top.

Use Tandy Bleach to clean, then rub on Neat Lac. Your beautiful "Spec" Case is worth approximately \$5.00.
